Bullying is repeated verbal, physical, social or psychological behaviour that is harmful and involves the misuse of power by an individual or group towards one or more persons. Cyber-bullying refers to bullying through information and communication technologies.

Bullying can involve humiliation, domination, intimidation, victimisation and all forms of harassment including that based on sex, race, disability, homosexuality or transgender. Bullying of any form or for any reason can have long-term effects on those involved including bystanders.



Deputy Principal to take action by:

A) Communicating with students and parents to seek an acceptable change in behaviour and attitude

B) Developing a Risk Assessment and communicating it to all staff

C) Accessing out of school resources and programs to support/rehabilitate

D) Issuing consequences (communication with parent/carer, red card, referral to Principal for a discipline meeting if continued bullying)

E) Recording on SENTRAL
