Nagasaki Nichidai High School is returning to Banora Point High School.



- Provide all meals
- Include students in all your normal weekly activities, including weekend activities
- Organise transport to and from school
- Have a NSW WWCC (Working With Children Check)

What do I get in return?

- The opportunity to share our Australian lifestyle and hospitality with students from Japan.
- Learn about living and studying in Japan
- Host families will be paid \$42 per student per night to assist with the costs involved with hosting.
