

DUX Selection Criteria

The following selection process was developed to ensure a fair and consistent process for the selection of the student to be awarded BPHS DUX.

- 1. The DUX must have completed a pattern of study that makes them eligible for an ATAR.
- 2. The DUX will be determined by the student who achieves the highest number of first places in the courses they had completed at HSC level.
- 3. Only Board Developed courses will be considered.
- 4. Extension courses will be considered as stand-alone courses, eg Extension 1 English will be considered as a separate course to Advanced English. Extension 1 Mathematics will be considered as a separate course to Mathematics.
- 5. Where students are the only student in the course, such as Extension 2 English or Extension 2 Mathematics, they will be ranked first place.
- 6. Where a student studies more than 2 English courses, a maximum of 2 first place rankings will be attributed to their English studies for the purpose of determining DUX.
- 7. Students rank in a Distance Education Course will be considered with respect to their rank within their DE class.
- 8. In the case of more than one student having the highest number of first places, a count back will occur to determine the DUX.
- A count back will include the student with the highest number of first and second places. In the event that a single DUX cannot identify by count back, the award of DUX will be awarded to more than one student.
- 10. The Principal has the final decision in determining DUX and can use the Principal's discretion to make reasonable adjustments to the process where required.
